

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION  
March 24, 2009; 7:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

A work session of the Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 211 West 3rd Street in the City Hall Council Chambers in the Municipal Building.
