CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT, SOUTH SIDE OF EAST PHILIP BETWEEN YORK AND WELCH

Mayor Livingston declared a Public hearing on an application for a Conditional Use Permit to construct a 130' telecommunications tower facility and related equipment located on the south side of East Philip Avenue between York and Welch Streets.

Derek McGrew, representing Horvath Communications, told the Council that a flashing red light would be placed on top of the tower for safety issues with the nearby airport, and the setback of the tower will be double what is required. He also indicated that the zoning of the property is agricultural, with existing natural landscape to screen the site and should not have any adverse effects on neighboring properties.
