2. Send application of Casey's Retail Company dba Casey's General Store #2163 for a Class D Liquor License (Beer, Wine & Distilled Spirits, Off Sale Only) located at 2421 Rodeo Road to the Liquor Control Commission with no recommendation.
3. Approve application of Mid Plains Food & Lodging, Inc. dba Holiday Plaza Conoco for a reconstruction to their license at 102 Holiday Frontage Road.

4. Receive Certificate of Completion from Engineering Department for Street Improvement District No. 321 (East Francis Street from 445 feet east of the centerline of South Poplar Street to the west right-of-way line of South Tabor Avenue) and accept said improvements.
5.
