

This year's Giving Day donations to the NPPL Foundation Fund will be used to purchase makerspace equipment and supplies for the North Platte Public Library.





The library will be <u>closed</u> May 6-23 to start construction of a Makerspace area on first floor.

Our library was accepted to be part of the Nebraska Library Commission's Innovation Studio grant project. You will be able to come to the library, take a class, try out the equipment, and then create, collaborate, and invent things.

Equipment includes a Laser Cutter, 3D Printer, Vinyl Cutter, CNC Router, Bernette Chicago Embroidery and Sewing Machine Station, Lego Mindstorms EV3 Kit, Laminator Kit, Arduino Starter Kit, Sparkfun Inventors Kit, Makey Makey Kit, Camera and Video Kit with Green Screen, Music and Recording Kit, and Button Making Kit

The Library will have the grant equipment from September 5, 2018 through January 20, 2019.



After that, the Library will be purchasing the most highly utilized equipment, based on customer usage and makerspace user feedback.
