CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Council of the City of North Platte, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 5:30 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers at 211 West 3rd Street. Present were Nisley, Tryon, Volz, Lucas, Garrick, Carman, Rieker, Woods. Mayor Brandon Kelliher presided and City Clerk Angela Gilbert recorded the proceedings.

Nisley moved that the rule requiring Ordinance No. 4051 to create Special Water Improvement District No. 3 to replace the existing 6" water main with an 8" water main along Reid Avenue
